



## Curve technique course 1 on Saturday, August 9 is **ALMOST** full: 3 of at least 4 participants have registered!

A brief recap: On July 5, we were able to hold the first course in 2025 with four participants in perfect weather conditions. All of the pictures were taken on that day. The course was conducted entirely in English, from the theory session the evening before to the final feedback session at the Badi Turbenthal swimming pool.

Whenever a course is announced, there are always participants for whom the date is not convenient. So it was clear that there would be another course. On August 6, the Brückenwaage restaurant, our new base since the Sternen restaurant in Fischingen was sold, will be closed for vacation. Three participants have already been confirmed, and we are looking for a fourth. The maximum number is six, preferably an even number, as certain exercises are done in pairs.

**To participate in the course**, you must have a **motorcycle license for cat. A1** (depending on the vehicle) **or cat. A**, restricted or unrestricted. The course is suitable for all motorcyclists, whether experienced, returning to riding, or beginners who have just passed their test: anyone who wants to systematically learn the basics of "safe cornering" will be guided step by step thanks to the unique course concept – the group experience is an essential part of this, as you can learn from each other.

What the course **CANNOT** do: If you have a personal problem with cornering due to your previous driving experience, this cannot be solved within the group, such as fear of leaning, unresolved traumatic experiences as a result of a fall or accident, etc. In such cases, I have always successfully enabled participation in the course with preparation in 1:1 training (double lesson in individual instruction). This allows me to address the "button in the system" specifically and provide relief with individual exercises without time pressure: The problem is usually in the mind!

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
